INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE STATEMENT

To: IBIDEN Co., Ltd.



Bureau Veritas Japan Co., Ltd. (Bureau Veritas) has been engaged by IBIDEN Co., Ltd. (IBIDEN) to provide limited assurance over sustainability information selected by IBIDEN. This Assurance Statement applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

Selected information

The scope of our assurance work was limited to assurance over the following information disclosed in the 'Environmental Initiatives' page and the 'Environmental Data' page of the IBIDEN's corporate website (the 'Website') or reported internally to IBIDEN Group only for the purpose of internal management for the period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023 (the 'Selected Information'):

- Energy usage and Greenhouse gas (CO_2 , CH_4 and N_2O) emissions through business operations of IBIDEN's nine sites within Japan, six group companies (ten sites) within Japan and eight group companies (eight sites) outside Japan
- Renewable energy usage at IBIDEN's nine sites within Japan and three group companies (three sites) outside Japan
- Category 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of Scope 3 GHG emissions accounted in line with the GHG Protocol's 'Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard' within the boundaries defined by IBIDEN for each category

Reporting criteria

The Selected Information included within the Website needs to be read and understood together with the reporting criteria stated in the Website.

The Selected Information reported internally to IBIDEN Group only for the purpose of internal management needs to be read and understood together with the internal reporting criteria defined by IBIDEN.

Limitations and Exclusions

Excluded from the scope of our work is any verification of information relating to:

- Activities outside the defined verification period;
- Any other information which is not listed as the Selected Information.

This limited assurance engagement relies on a risk based selected sample of sustainability data and the associated limitations that this entails. This independent statement should not be relied upon to detect all errors, omissions or misstatements that may exist.

Responsibilities

This preparation and presentation of the Selected Information in the Website are the sole responsibility of the management of IBIDEN.

Bureau Veritas was not involved in the drafting of the Website or of the Reporting Criteria. Our



responsibilities were to:

- obtain limited assurance about whether the Selected Information has been prepared in accordance with the Reporting Criteria by conducting our assurance work;
- form an independent conclusion based on the assurance procedures performed and evidence obtained; and
- report our conclusions to the Directors of IBIDEN.

Assessment Standard

We performed our work in accordance with International Standard on Assurance Engagements (ISAE) 3000 (Revised), Assurance Engagements Other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information (Effective for assurance reports dated on or after December 15, 2015) issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board.

For the greenhouse gas emissions data, we undertook verification in accordance with the requirements of ISO14064-3 (2019): Greenhouse gases - Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements.

Summary of work performed

As part of our independent verification, our work included:

- 1. Conducting interviews with relevant personnel of IBIDEN;
- Reviewing the data collection and consolidation processes used to compile Selected Information, including assessing assumptions made, and the data scope and reporting boundaries;
- 3. Reviewing documentary evidence provided by IBIDEN;
- 4. Reviewing IBIDEN systems for quantitative data aggregation and analysis;
- 5. Verification of sample of data back to source by carrying out three physical site or section visits, selected on a risk based bases at the following locations:
 - IBIDEN Strategic Manufacturing Operation GX Promotion Division
 - IBIDEN Ogaki Central Plant
 - IBIDEN Kinuura Plant
- 6. Reperforming a selection of aggregation calculations of the Selected Information;
- 7. Comparing the Selected Information to the prior year amounts taking into consideration changes in business activities, acquisitions and disposals.

The procedures performed in a limited assurance engagement vary in nature and timing from, and are less in extent than for, a reasonable assurance engagement.

Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

Verified greenhouse gas emissions

We performed our verification work on greenhouse gas emissions data in accordance with the requirements of ISO14064-3(2019).

Verified data in greenhouse gas assertion made by IBIDEN are as follows.
