IBIDEN Hungary, Kft's to Construct New Technical Center

IBIDEN Hungary, Kft., a consolidated subsidiary of IBIDEN CO., LTD. (President & CEO: Hiroki Takenaka, Head Office: Ogaki City, Gifu Prefecture, Japan), has decided to construct a technical center for development and research on DPFs (diesel particulate filters) and other products to control motor vehicle emissions. The company will acquire a construction site adjacent to its current facility on the west side.

<Outline of Scheduled Capital Investment>

Contents of investment: Land acquisition and construction of the technical center

Site area: 95,900 m² (the land adjacent to IBIDEN Hungary, Kft. on the west side)

Start of production: Full-scale operation slated for December 2008

Investment amount:

About 1 billion yen (calculated at the exchange rate of 160 yen per euro; development facility costs excluded)

Objectives:

With the approach of "Euro 5," Europe's next-generation environmental regulation, demand for DPFs and other products to reduce motor vehicle emissions is expected to increase. IBIDEN Hungary, Kft. will reinforce its development capacity in the European Region and acquire the construction site for further business expansion.
